- Change of legislation will force the collection system to change from mainly bottle bank to 100 % curb-side collection, by 2025.
- Cost of collecting all packaging containers, regardless of material, will sky-rocket.
- Increased volumes from curb-side collection reduces total incoming quality

#### Measures and Actions

- We may have to abandon color separation in the collection system as there will be cost benefits involved once we go to 100 % curb-side collection.
- Major increase in packaging recycling fees.
- Need to update the recycling plant to adapt to "new" specifications on incoming material. We need to address an significant increase in impurities such as plastic, paper, stones, ceramics and porcelaine.
